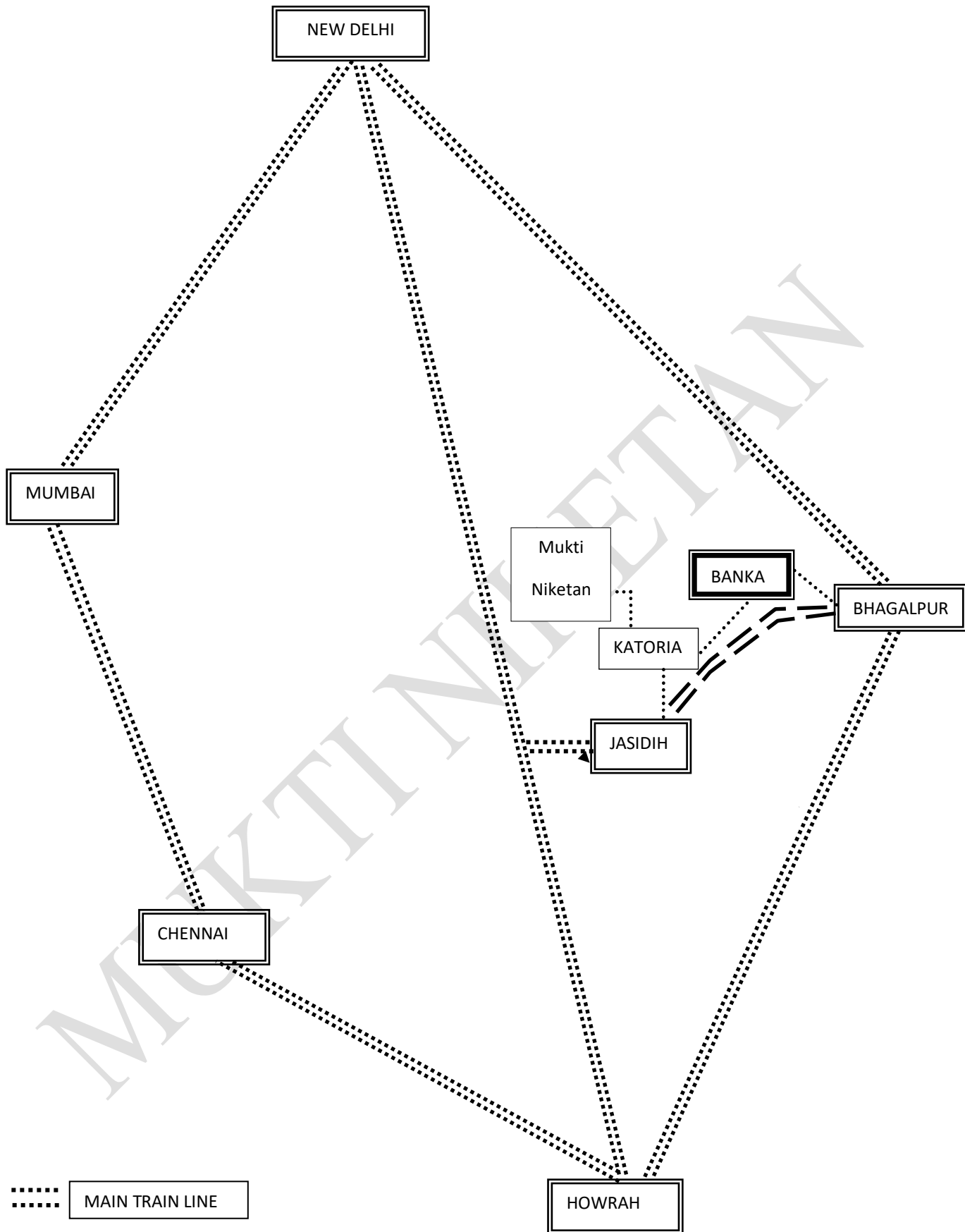

Introduction

“Mukti Niketan” Was established in the area on January 21st 1985 in the form of an Educational Institution to address the causes of Education of the weaker families, weaker in the sense of economical as well as social capabilities. It was able to earn credibility and rapport in the area but by and by it was felt that mere Student Education could not bring real happiness on the faces of the mass. It could be done only by Community Education. Hence objectives of the Organization were modified from educational and academic to Community - Capacifation and Development. **“Mukti Niketan”** was decided to be converted from an Education Institution to a Voluntary Organization – **“Mukti Niketan Bhagalpur”**. It was then registered in 1988 under S.R.A., in 1992 under F.C.R.A and in 1997 under Income Tax Act respectively. It was supported by Gandhi Peace Centre Hyderabad, CORT New Delhi, RGVN Patna, and Governmental Agencies, CAPART, DFID, CFLI, NFI, PACS, CCF, NABARD and others. Since its establishment, **“Mukti Niketan”** has been initiating possible steps and approaches meant for the cause of the communities, specially, the weak, the poor, the marginalized and the bereaved ones including women and youth. It has been trying its level best to tackle the need based issues and problems of the communities, groups and individuals at large.

Education, Health, Community Awareness, Women Empowerment, Water Management, Environmental Up-gradation, Watershed Development, Relief and Emergency Assistance, Liaison and Linkages have been our priority areas of intervention.

Benefit to the needy is the key to our approaches. We fight for Social justice. Social cohesion, co-operation, brotherhood and unity. These constitute our Aim.

The Organization utilizes local resources, resources from the governmental agencies, funders, non governmental units and individuals to address the causes of beneficiaries.

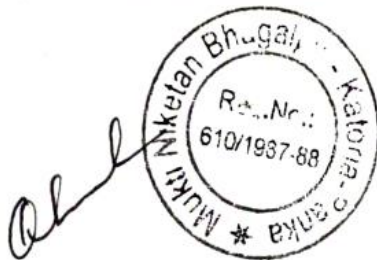

Major Learnings

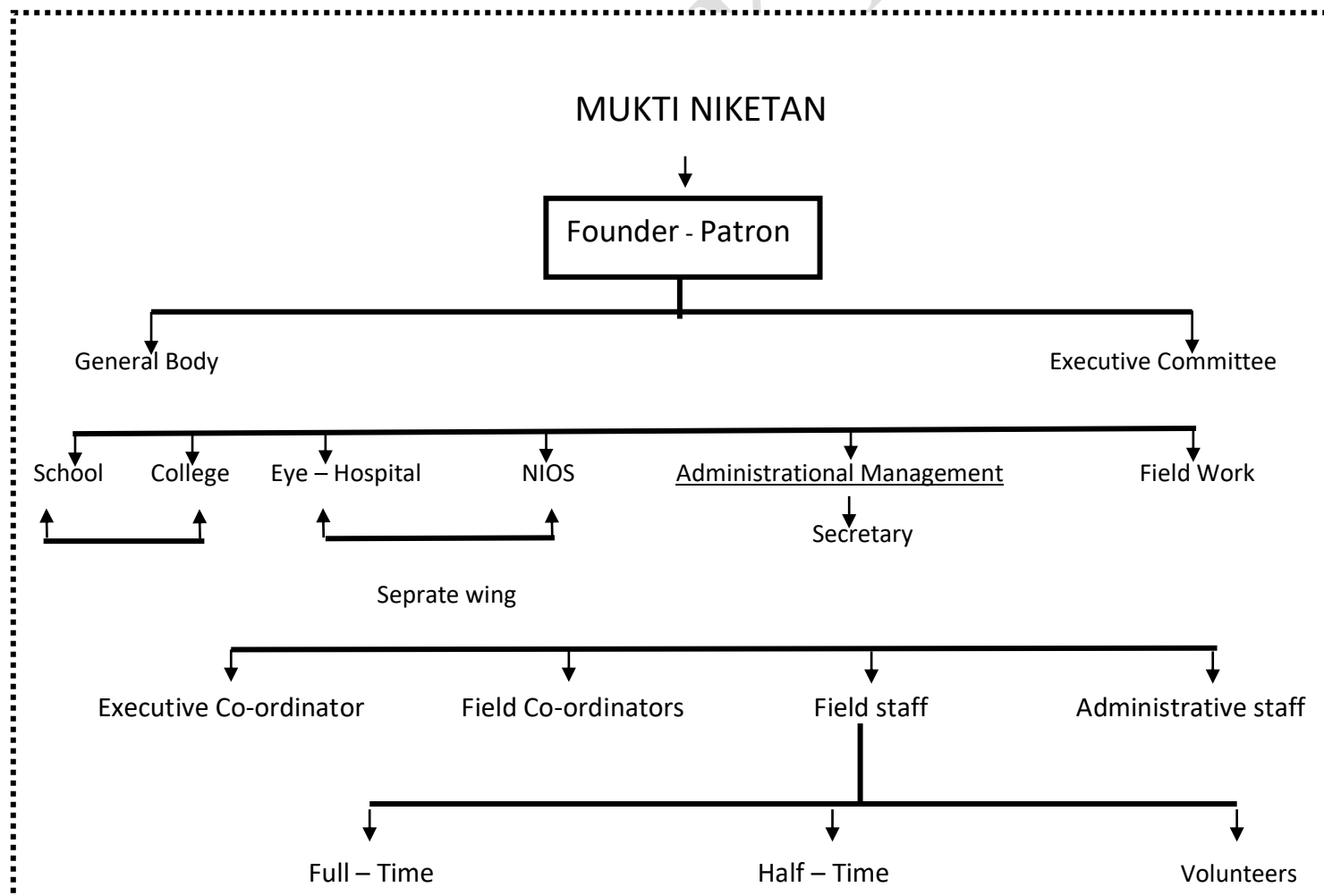
Its long term efforts, experiences, achievements and unsuccesses have strengthened it with some very good learning's which can be mentioned as follows:

Main Activities And Impact

The Organization carries out mainly two types of activities – Self Managed Self Dependent Activities and project – based sponsored Activities.

A. Self Managed Activities :-

- Irrigation
- Cultivation
- Awareness, sensitization and Assistance
- Cultural
- Vocational
- Trainings

B. Project – Based Sponsored Activities:-

Organization applies for fund to Government Agencies and Non – governmental Funders for funds to address the needs and issues on the subjects of Education, Health, Development, Training and Protection of Children's right and welfare.

- (A) The Organization has developed its own resource, infrastructure and recourses person to run some of the activities on its own on a Sustainable ground. The following units bear Some incredible importance to our efforts for social transformation.

i. Education:-

Education has been the most important Component of our approaches to inspire and guide the Community Continually for betterment.

(a) National Institute of open Schooling :-

“**Mukti Niketan**” in 2001 was accredited to NIOS to cater the dire educational needs of the backward area covered in Bhagalpur Commissionaire and the Surrounding region on area backwards ground. To – day the study centre code is 450082 . Boys or girls who fail to attend formal Schools properly, call appear at Matriculation and after passing may join to regular courses of education to prosper and grow.

Candidates who fail at an exam can also appear at NIOS centers compartmentally or wholly to mend their career.

This unit of distance education has enabled hundreds and hundreds of boys and girls to enter into a new phase of life to get higher education and opportunities of employment.

(a) **Pratibha Bhaskar Vidyalaya :-**

Established in 2012 in the Organizational campus it has been a school from class Nursery upto class VIII. It has been affiliated by the Govt. of Bihar under Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan bearing the Affiliation No SSA/RTE/BAK/2015-'16/54.

The School runs on five language formula. Hindi, English, Urdu, Sanskrit and Computer teaching have been the five languages being taught compulsorily to all students in the school. Vocational Education has been introduced in the school. Three quarterly Exams and one Final Examination is strictly conducted in every academic session.

To make English learning easier, books introduced are in English whereas medium of instruction has been Hindi. Children write answers in the English only. Teachers are local. They prepare before they teach. Weekly examination has been a normal habit. Tuition to children are forbidden.

Children come from nearby villages and the range of villages goes to 15 kms. Hired vehicles are used to carry children. Number of children varies between 190 to 220.

It runs in a separate building with electricity and Sanilational facilities. Under extracurricular activities children learn cultural activities, Yoga, Karate and Social obligations.



(b) **Mahatma Gandhi Shikshak Prashikshan Mahavidyalaya:-**

The training college was established in 2008 for opeaning B.Ed. sessions. It was accredited to NCTE Regional office Bhubneshwar and Affiliated to TMBU – Bhagalpur. In the first session 2009 – 2010 total 100 students were admitted. The College started **D.El.Ed.** course from 2017 – 2019 session after getting approval from the govt. of Bihar.

The college has a sepera building with adequate infrastructure, furniture,



equipments, facilities and library, bounded compound and play ground as per the norm of the Govt. of India equipped with required no. of teaching and Non – teaching staff. The college has earned a good reputation in the University.

(ii) Health Initiatives :-

Health Serves have remained Organization's Special priority. Since the Organization was established, It has been rendering various health related Services to the People, Health and Medical camps were being organized to provide free Check Up facilities Under free Treatment options in the areas of the General. Physicianship, Gyno chology and surgery. The range of the service covered a broad area from kolgong via Bhagalpur, NathNager and Bounsi up to Katoria with the Technical Collaboration with IMA – Bhagalpur when Bhagalpur contained Banka District in itself. In 1989 the Organization's own Mini – Hospital "Sanjivini" was opened. Then there were very few agencies to render medical services. Through sanjivini Mukti Niketan Provided free and connibution based service in all sectors of patients including surgical and Plastic Surgery. Renowned Philon thropist Plastic Surge Dr. P. R Chakravorty, Dr. Amarish kumar Singh, Dr Suresh Prasad, Dr. Shyam Sundar Singh and Dr. Arun Kumar Singh rendered voluntary treanment and surgery to hundreds of ailing people in the area.



Mukti Niketan assisted various governmental programmes related to awareness and service delivery of polio-iradication in all sorts of ways it could.

In Bhagalpur region, Specially in Banka District the need of an Eye – Care Institute could not be established. Then in 2006 the organization changed Sanjivini into "Baba Baidya Nath Netra Chikitsa Santhan" to deliver dedicated care to Eye – problem including refraction, O.P.D .services, spectacle – making, awareness and screening camps and Lens transplantation in its own O.T. by experienced competent doctors.

To attain expertise in profession and good infrastructure in this field has been the prime need of Organization.

(iii) Demonstrative Irrigation And Agriculture :-

The Organization has got expertise in raising Lift – Irrigation systems in hilly undulated areas to carry water for irrigation from lower level to a higher field plane with diesel – driven pump set or electrically driven motor.

The tradition of irrigation with flood water has to be replaced through micro – irrigation, drip – irrigation and sprinkler irrigation systems. Chemical fertilizers, pesticides and pre-servants have to be replaced by organic ones. New patterns of cultivating crops and vegetables in mixed crop and multilayer bowing patterns have to be inculcation. The Organization has been doing all these in its field in a demonstrative way.

With active support of people who know the Organization, we see to make the wings of Education, Health and Agriculture improved to a standard status.
